Learned State counsel, at the outset, has opposed the prayer made on behalf of the petitioner for extending him the concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. He, on instructions, has submitted that the petitioner is involved in one other case of similar nature, wherein also he had fired at the police party, as a result of which, a case under Sections 307, 336 IPC stands registered against him. It has been further submitted that in the case in hand, charges have not yet been framed.

In the circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would not press the instant petition at this stage.
