The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No.53 dated 21.05.2022, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act and Sections 186, 353, 225 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Khoom Kalan, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the following order dated 27.12.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that neither the petitioner was named in the FIR in question nor any contraband recovered from her. He submits that the petitioner was being sought to be arrayed as an accused for allegedly pelting stones at the police party and creating obstacles for it when the police apprehended the main accused Santokh Singh from whom recovery of 2 kgs. Of poppy husk was effected. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Major Singh does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. He further states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 27.12.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
