The instant petition was preferred by the petitioner seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for grant of deemed date of promotion him as an Xen with all consequential benefits alongwith correction of fixation of pay, allowances and arrears accrued on that account alongwith interest on the delayed payment, etc. w.e.f. 05.06.2017, when the private respondent no.5 namely Mahavir Prasad, Xen (Retd.) was promoted.

Though on earlier occasion a written statement was filed and the case was heard, however, Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Advocate, appearing on behalf of the respondents no.2 to 4-DHBN produced a copy of order dated 18.07.2023, which shows that as per the order dated 08.05.2023, passed by this Court, revision of seniority list of JE has been made and Sh.Mahavir

Prasad, Xen (Retd.)-respondent no.5 has now been placed at Sr. No.358A as against the seniority of petitioner Kuldeep Singh, AE (Retd.)(at Sr. No.357).

In the light of the same, nothing survives in the instant petition.

However, it is further made clear that all consequential benefits arising on that account including the deemed date promotion, re-fixation of allowances, arrears, whatsoever, if any, due to the petitioner in accordance with law shall be released forthwith, within a period of two months of from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of accordingly.
