1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents to transfer the investigation of the case FIR No. 0054 dated 06.04.2021 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur to the office of respondent No. 3, i.e., Bureau of Investigation, Punjab Police, at Chandigarh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Additional Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-4), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case

respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Additional Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 15.09.2023 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
