JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

On 12.01.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Status report by way of affidavit dated 10.01.2023 of Munish Sehgal, Asstt. Commissioner of Police, Women Safety Faridabad, is taken on record. The Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

Learned counsels for the parties are ad-idem that there is possibility of settlement if matter is referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Let this matter be referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The parties are directed to appear on 18.01.2023 before Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In the meantime, Investigating Officer is directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner.

For awaiting the report of Mediation and Conciliation Centre, list on 06.02.2023.”

Learned counsels for the parties are *ad-idem* that the matter stands settled between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that complainant has no objection if the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.01.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C

The petitioner is directed to appear before Investigating Officer as and when required and co-operate the conclusion of investigation.

If the petitioner or his family members/associates make any attempt to threat/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted by this order.

Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as expression of opinion of this Court on merits of the case and Trial Court shall proceed without being prejudiced by observations of this Court.
