Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a legal notice dated 05.11.2022 (Annexure P-7) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural Amritsar and he shall be satisfied in case an appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into his legal notice dated 05.11.2022 (Annexure P-7).

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No. 2- Senior

Superintendent of Police, Rural Amritsar to look into the matter and take appropriate action as expeditiously as possible, in accordance with law.
