1. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.92 dated 01.06.2018, under Sections 323, 379, 506 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that when the petitioner had filed an application for grant of anticipatory bail before the learned Sessions Court, Amritsar then it was so directed while disposing of the said application that the petitioner shall surrender before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of ten days from the date of the passing of the order and on his doing so, the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate shall admit the petitioner to bail to its satisfaction, subject to cost of Rs.1,000/- to be paid by the petitioner in DLSA, Amritsar. She further submitted that the

aforesaid order was passed on 08.06.2023 and now the aforesaid period of ten days has expired and the petitioner could neither deposit the cost nor could he surrender in time and in this regard reasons can be shown to the learned Sessions Court, Amritsar and she may be permitted to withdraw the present petition in order to enable the petitioner to file a fresh application before the learned Sessions Court, Amritsar since the period of aforesaid ten days has expired but now the petitioner wishes to surrender before the Court and comply with the aforesaid order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar.

3. In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a fresh application before the learned Sessions Court, Amritsar in this regard. In case any fresh application is filed by the petitioner then the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law and in case any prayer is made for the extension of time, then the same shall also be considered in accordance with law.
