This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to
demolish/remove the encroachment made by respondent no.5 in front of his
house.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents no.2 to 4 has
submitted that the encroachment in question has been removed by
respondent no.5.

On 29.05.2019, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to
pass the following order:-

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Vikrant Pamboo, DAG, Haryana causes appearance on behalf of respondent No. 1 and 3 and Mr.Jagdish Manchanda, Advocate causes representation on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 4. Copies of paper book have been supplied to them in the Court today.

Respondent No.2 is directed to ensure that no constructions against the building norms including one indicated in the petition will be raised in the area.

Post again on 6.9.2019, the date already fixed in the main case.
