The present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner seeking directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and take appropriate legal action on the representation/complaint dated 24.02.2023 (Annexure P-3).

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner, being aggrieved by the acts and conducts of respondents No.4 and 5, has moved the representation (Annexure P-3) dated 24.02.2023 to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, but no action thereon has been taken and even thereafter he moved a reminder (Annexure P-4) dated 18.10.2023 to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, but nothing has been done. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2- The Senior

Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-4) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
- 5. After considering the respective submissions and considering the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is, hereby, disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3 and Annexure P-4) preferably within 8 weeks from today in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 7. Disposed of.
