The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to issue the Birth Certificate of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the Birth Certificate of the petitioner is not being issued to her and that the same is urgently required by her for immigration purposes.

It is apparent from perusal of the writ petition that there is no averment as regards the petitioner having applied for issuance of such Birth Certificate. A representation purportedly submitted by the petitioner cannot be perceived as submission of her application for issuance of a Birth Certificate.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G. Punjab appears and accepts

notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in the event of the petitioner submitting the application for issuance of a Birth Certificate alongwith requisite fee etc. the concerned department will consider the request as per law within time bound manner.

Taking into consideration the circumstances pointed out by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit an appropriate application alongwith requisite fee to the concerned authority for issunace of a Birth Certificate. Neeless to add that the requisite certificate shall be issued expeditiously as per law and in a time bound manner on filing of such application.

Petition is disposed of.
