The present application has been filed seeking review of order dated 08.12.2022 passed by this Court.

In the present case, notice was issued to Mr. Ved Prakash, Advocate for the respondent, by this Court on 20.11.2023, as on that date learned counsel for the applicant/appellant had informed the Court that an information has been received from learned counsel for the respondent that the matter can be resolved between the parties, if the matter be sent to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. However, Mr. Ved Prakash, Advocate who is present in the Court along with respondent, her son Kuljot Singh and father Darshan Singh, submitted that the respondent has come long way from Rai Singh Nagar, Rajasthan to attend the Court proceedings and state that there are no chances of amicable settlement between the parties and respondent has never assured the appellant that the matter can be resolved between the parties.

Today, the case has been called thrice but none has put in appearance on behalf of the applicant-appellant and efforts were also made by the Court staff to contact Ms. Savita Devi, learned counsel for the appellant, on her mobile phone but all in vain.

Learned counsel for the respondent has further informed the Court that appellant is very much present in the premises of this Court today but is not coming forward.

In view of the above factual position, the present application is dismissed. However, a cost of Rs.20,000/- as litigation expenses, is imposed upon the appellant to be paid to the respondent, who had come from Rajasthan along with her son and old aged father.
