This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide one more opportunity to appear in the exam of HTET Computer Science as early as possible.

Learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 has submitted that a candidate can avail any number of chances for the exam, till the maximum age is attained by the candidate for the said exam and thus, the present petition is misconceived.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the arguments raised by learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3. No one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on 28.09.2022.
