Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 43 days
in filing the Review Application.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly
supported by an affidavit of the applicant-petitioner, the same is allowed.

Delay of 43 days in filing the Review Application is condoned.

RA-CW-530-2019

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the
parties and keeping in view the fact that the land, which has been purchased
by the petitioner from a subsequent seller, who had bought the land from the
original allottee, does not relate to either a disabled ex-serviceman or a
widow of an ex-serviceman, the condition with regard to the non-selling of
the same within a period of ten years would not be applicable. He on this
basis contends that the judgment passed by this Court in *CWP No.21658 of
2018* titled as *Doaba Nirmal Mandal (Regd.), District Jalandhar and
another Versus The Financial Commissioner Revenue & Secretary to Govt.
of Punjab, Chandigarh*, decided on 24.01.2019, would not be applicable to
the case of the petitioner.

In the light of the above, the prayer made in this application for review of the order dated 25.09.2019 is accepted.

Order dated 25.09.2019 is recalled and the case is restored to its original number.
