On 04.12.2018, the following order was passed:

“CRR(F)-612-2018

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to get instructions if the petitioner is willing to pay 50% of the total arrears of maintenance amounting to Rs.1,82,000/- consequent upon which the impugned orders have been passed. List on 13.12.2018.”

On 20.05.2019 following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very onset submits that the petitioner is willing to deposit 50% of the due amount as on date within one month from today. Adjourned to 26.11.2019 for compliance.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to apprise the Court whether petitioner has complied with order dated 20.05.2019 or not. A period of more than 4 years has already passed away and learned counsel for the petitioner has no instruction with respect to compliance of said order.

There seems to be no reason to keep the petition pending.

Disposed of.

The petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
