Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the complaint dated 21.08.2023 (Annexure P-7) and to take action on the same in time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed the representation dated 21.08.2023 (Annexure P-7). He submits that petitioner earlier filed the representation to the Secretary, Municipal Corporation, Ambala for entering the name and corrected area in the property ID and thereafter, he filed the present representation. He submits that regarding the allegations made in the complaint for asking bribe, he would avail his independent remedy and thus, do not pursue the complaint filed for the same. However, for rest of the contentions, the representation filed be decided as in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.2-Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana is directed to decide the complaint dated 21.08.2023 (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within four weeks from today in accordance with law. It would be taken into consideration that the petitioner has already withdrawn his prayer regarding the demand of bribe from the complainant by availing the independent remedy qua the same.
