1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to decide the representation dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-4), which was addressed to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that two vehicles of which he is registered owner are in possession of his wife and he has apprehension that it will be used against him during the trial which he is presently facing in FIR No. 19 dated 29.02.2016 under Sections 307, 498-A, 406, 323 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.
3. Learned State counsel has informed that petitioner has already made a statement on 21.11.2023, whereby he has stated that the said vehicles are in possession of his wife and has no objection, if the said vehicles are transferred in the name of his wife and he does not want to take any action on the said representation. Copy of the said statement has been presented in Court today, which is taken on record.
4. Faced with such situation, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take appropriate remedy before the trial Court.
5. Ordered accordingly.
