By filing the instant revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuing the direction to learned Additional District Judge, Chandigarh (for short 'the trial Court') to decide the petition bearing **HMA No.829 of 2021** titled as '**Sandeep Singh vs. Rabinder Kaur**' within some specific time frame, while averring that he had filed the afore-mentioned petition against the respondent in October 2021, for seeking the dissolution of their marriage but she (respondent) has not even filed her written statement therein.

Keeping in view the facts that the above-referred petition is pending adjudication for the last two years and is still at the stage of filing of the written statement and thus, the trial is yet to commence therein and also without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the same, the revision petition in hand is disposed of with direction to the concerned trial Court to conclude the trial proceedings and to decide the afore-said HMA petition, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
