The instant writ petition had been filed for seeking quashing of notice dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) for re-inquiry vide which the petitioners had been directed to appear before the respondent No.2-Commission on 05.10.2018 for re-inquiry in case bearing FIR No.09 dated 28.01.2016 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Annexure P-1) at Police Station, Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the contentions raised by the petitioners in the present case were duly noticed vide order dated 01.10.2018 when further proceedings before the Commission were ordered to be stayed. He further submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the term of the Commission has already come to an end and as such, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

Needless to mention here that the petitioners would be at liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies as and when cause of action accrues again.
