The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.630 dated 04.11.2022 registered under Sections 323, 34, 506 IPC (Section 34 IPC removed and Sections 325 and 307 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

By virtue of the order dated 30.12.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rohtash, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 30.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
