SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by the concerned, submits that in terms of the orders passed by this Court (Annexure P-5), the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, has instituted a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 before the Collector concerned, for thereby lawful orders being passed by the Collector concerned, against the encroachers on *Gair Mumkin Phirni*. If so, in terms of paragraph no. 4 of Annexure P-5, the said petition be decided within four months.

2. Moreover, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by Mr. Prince Bains, Samiti Patwari, Block Morinda., also submits that the complete demarcation report to be made on the disputed site by the empowered revenue officer concerned, has not yet been prepared. Therefore, he submits that as and when the complete demarcation report is prepared by the empowered revenue officer, and, if thereins speakings occur, that encroachment(s) are made by other encroachers also, upon, the

against the said encroachers within two weeks from today. All the relevant petitions shall be clubbed, and, shall also be decided through a common verdict.

3. Moreover, the learned State counsel also submits that any eviction petition which has been filed against the present petitioner, has been withdrawn, as such, the grievance ventilated before this Court, by the counsel for the petitioner, that he has been unnecessarily dragged, into litigation rather becomes completely mitigated.

4. In view of the above observations, the petition is disposed of alongwith all pending applications.
