The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay the due amount of Rs. 14,30,792/- qua the works executed by the petitioner, alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had executed various works assigned to him from time to time and there has never been any complaint against the works executed by the petitioner. The petitioner has been allotted various works vide different work orders in the year 2021. The petitioner has successfully completed the aforesaid work within stipulated time period and the entry regarding the same is also done in the official record of the concerned department. It is further submitted that at

the time of making the payments of all the works, a security amount was deducted while making payment of running as well as final bills, which is due to be released after a period of one year of the completion of work. There is no complaint against the work but till date the due payment has not been released to the petitioner. The petitioner approached the respondents for a number of times, but nothing fruitful could be fetched. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted numerous representations including latest representation dated 08.08.2023 (Annexure P-18) upon respondent No.4-Corporation Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Moga but the respondents-authorities neither responded to the same nor did they make the payment of outstanding amount to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Teevar Sharma, Asstt. A.G. Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1.

Mr. Saurav Verma, who is the Additional Advocate General Punjab and would thus be on the panel of all statutory Board and Corporations of the State of Punjab has been requested to accept notice on behalf of the respondent No.2 to 4-Municipal Corporation, Moga.

On the asking of the Court, he accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 to 4-Municipal Corporation, Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.3-the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moga is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 08.08.2023 (Annexure P-18) in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3-the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Moga to consider and decide the representation dated 08.08.2023 (Annexure P-18) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in his favour within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
