The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.221 dated 15.11.2022 registered under Sections 27 and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 30.12.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
