The petitioners have filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and they had performed the marriage against the wishes of the family of petitioner No.1 and are apprehending imminent threat at the hands of her family.

On advance notice, Mr.Vipin Pal Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, appears in the Court and on instructions, submits that the local police had called the parents of petitioner No.1 and they have submitted that they have no objection to the abovestated marriage and would not interfere in their matrimonial affairs.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant petition and is accordingly, disposed of.

Since the main case has been disposed of, there is no necessity of passing further orders in the said application and the same is accordingly disposed of.
