Prayer made in the present writ petition is for issuance of
directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to take action against illegal
operation of a Banquet Hall by respondent No.6.

A status report by way of affidavit of Satyawar Singh
Mann, Estate Officer, HSVP, Panipat has been filed on behalf of
respondents No.1 to 5 wherein it has been averred that they have
already taken decision for forfeiture of the Multiplex Site in Sector-11,
Urban Estate, Panipat allotted in the name of D.A.P. Estates Private

Limited alongwith forfeiture of 10% of the total amount of the consideration money of site for violation of law.

A copy of the order dated 29.11.2023 passed by the Estate Officer-HSVP, Panipat has also been attached alongwith the said Status report.

In view of the aforesaid status report filed by the Estate Officer, HSVP, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

Counsel for respondent No.6 submits that the cost of Rs. 50,000/- in compliance of the order dated 02.08.2023 has already been deposited.

The respondent No.6, shall be, however, at liberty to pursue his remedies in accordance with law.
