Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.223 dated 27.08.2022 under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (Section 29 added later on), registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

The case has been registered in pursuance of the recovery of 95 gms of intoxicating substance from the possession of Roop Lal @ Roopa, co-accused. The petitioner has been nominated on the basis of the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the report of FSL, diacetylmorphine (heroin) has been found in the parcel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner shall surrender in the concerned Court within a period of 7 days. He seeks to withdraw the petition and restricts his prayer only to the extent that appropriate directions may be issued to the concerned Court for expeditious disposal of the bail application.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, it is directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders before the concerned Court within a period of 7 days, the feasibility of expeditious disposal of the bail application may be considered after the conclusion of the police remand, if any.
