Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.160 dated 4.12.2022 registered under Sections 336 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 29 and 30 of Arms Act at Police Station Ghanaur, District Patiala.

The allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner fired shots in the air during a marriage function.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of previous order dated 3.1.2023 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court.

State counsel on instructions from from ASI Rajinder Kumar has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the firearm used by the petitioner stands recovered and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 3.1.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
