The petitioners are alleging violation of the order dated 27.03.2019, passed by this Court in CWP-26128-2018, vide which, the writ petition was disposed of in terms of another writ petition i.e. CWP-403-2016, titled as Khushi Ram Gupta vs. State of Haryana, wherein a direction was issued to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners therein for the grant of benefit of claimed pay scale in case it is found that the petitioners were working against 20% of the cadre post on the relevant date i.e. 01.01.1996.

Reply, by way of the affidavits of the Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Finance Department as well as Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana, Public Works Department, have been filed today in Court. The same are taken on record. As per the affidavits, only one petitioner, i.e. petitioner No. 4-Rajinder Singh Yadav, was found to be falling within 20% of the cadre post and he has been granted the requisite relief, however, other six petitioners were not found eligible.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered

infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioners are granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
