Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the transfer order dated 15.12.2022, whereby respondent No.2 transfer the private respondents at the place of posting of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 are working as Sweepers and petitioner No.3 is working as Peon at Faridabad and respondent Nos. 4 to 8 have been posted at the place of posting of the petitioners.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and have also gone through the documents on record.

Perusal of record would itself reveal that neither any document/order indicating that the petitioners have been transferred from

their current place of posting has been placed on record, nor the learned counsel for the petitioners produced any such document in the Court.

Since there is no documents qua the transfers of the petitioners from their current place of posting, no case for grant of relief as prayed for is made out.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
