The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.1686 dated 15.10.2022 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram.

By virtue of the order dated 01.02.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ESI Vijay, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.
