The petitioners allege non-compliance of the order dated 18.12.2017 passed in CWP No.13344 of 2015.

Admittedly, all the petitioners, except petitioners No.10 and 21, have been granted the necessary benefits.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that petitioner No.10 namely Shakuntla Devi, is in fact, a PGT teacher in Sanskrit and she is entitled to be adjusted on the post of PGT Hindi by way of promotion in terms of the Haryana Government Gazette Notification dated 11.04.2012, vide which the Haryana State Education School Cadre (Group B) Service Rules, 2012 were amended.

Counsel for the petitioners has referred to Clause 4 Appendix B under Rule 7, to submit that the petitioner qualified the eligibility condition.

Similar is the stand with regard to petitioner No.21 namely Birbal Singh, who is teaching Mathematics as TGT and seeking promotion to the post of PGT Political Science.

As per the affidavit filed by the Director Elementary Education, a specific stand has been taken with regard to petitioners No.10 and 21. It is submitted that regarding promotion to the post of PGT Hindi, the petitioner No.10 Shakuntla Devi, is not eligible to be promoted as per the judgment. Similarly, it is stated that Birbal Singh, who is presently working as Math Master has stated that though he possessed the qualification of TGT Science but has not requisite experience of 02 years, therefore, both the petitioners No.10 and 21 do not fulfill the qualification.

In view of the above, no willful disobedience of the order is made out and the petition is dismissed accordingly.
