The present application seeks leave to appeal against the order of dismissal of the complaint filed by the applicant under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, for non-prosecution on 21.08.2017 by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rajpura.

There is an application under Section 5 of the limitation Act also of condonation of delay of 349 days in filing the appeal.

No one has appeared on behalf of the applicant.

A perusal of the record shows that on the last date of hearing also no one had appeared on behalf of the applicant.

It appears that the applicant whose complaint was dismissed for non-prosecution way back on 21.08.2017 after which the present application was filed with a delay of 349 days is not interested in pursuing the present application.
