DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

The present intra Court appeal is directed against the order dated 25.08.2023 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court disposing of respondent No.8's petition with issuance of a direction to the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Moga (for short-the BDPO) to decide respondent No.8's representation. Also under challenge is the order dated 19.10.2023 through which an application filed by the appellant seeking therein review of the aforesaid order has been dismissed.

(2) Through order dated 25.08.2023, the learned Single Judge has simply disposed of respondent No.8's petition with a direction to the BDPO to decide respondent No.8's representation in accordance with law. Its an innocuous order. It does not prejudice the appellant. Therefore, against the same, the appellant cannot maintain the present intra Court appeal.

(3) Similarly, there being no apparent error in the aforesaid order dated 25.08.2023, the learned Single Judge has rightly dismissed the appellant's review application. While dismissing the same, the learned Single Judge has also granted liberty to the appellant to pursue his remedies that may be available to him in law if he is aggrieved by the decision of the BDPO on respondent No.8's representation.

(4) In the light of the above, we find no reason to interfere with the orders impugned before us.

(5) Dismissed.

(6) It is again clarified that if in case the decision of the BDPO taken on respondent No.8's representation is to the appellant's prejudice, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.

(7) All pending miscellaneous application(s) also stand disposed of.
