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Instant petition has been preferred UNDER Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1), and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-2). Details of the FIR are as under: -

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[2]. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially the FIR was registered against 08 accused and vide order dated 02.05.2023 passed by this Court in *CRM-M-13032-2023*, titled as '*Rajat and others vs. State of Haryana and others*', FIR in question (Annexure P-1) qua the other accused has already been quashed.

[3]. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that with the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

[4]. Learnd D/Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra, vide report dated 11.12.2023 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[5]. Respondents Nos. 2 to 4 are represented by their counsel and do not oppose the compromise.

[6]. In view of the aforesaid report of the learned D/Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "*Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another*", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "*Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another*", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this

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Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the respondents themselves compromised the dispute with the petitioner.

[7]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 384 dated 02.11.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC, registered at P.S. Ladwa, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioner.
