1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is not being given weekly off and other compensatory leave for working beyond working hours which action of the department is arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the other prayer which has been raised qua the disciplinary action to be taken against respondent No. 5 may kindly be treated as having been not pressed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been made by the petitioner in the representation dated 22.09.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-16, and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case the representation, Annexure P-16, has been received in the office of the concerned authority and the same is still pending consideration, appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks and in case, after the passing of the order, the relief is to be given to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her within a further period of 4 weeks.
- 6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
- 7. Ordered accordingly.
