1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0107 dated 14.10.2023 under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

2. After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to extend the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner, learned counsel has made a prayer that he would not press the instant petition, however he submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court below and he be protected till then.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the relevant material on record.

4. The petition is dismissed as not pressed, however, in view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel, the petitioner is directed

to appear and surrender before the Court below/Illaq Magistrate within seven days from today and move appropriate application for grant of bail. Till then, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner. The Court below, on such application for bail being moved by the petitioner, shall decide it expeditiously, in accordance with the provisions of law. However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to surrender before the Court below within the above stipulated time period, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter.
