1. Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that except petitioner No.4, all the other petitioners have already been granted the benefit of increment on account of acquiring the higher qualifications.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that even petitioner No.4 is also entitled for the said benefit, hence, petitioner No.4 be given liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation raising the claim along with required documents.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case any claim is raised by petitioner No.4 by filing appropriate representation, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to petitioner No.4 to file appropriate representation.
