VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, direction or order for directing respondents no.1 and 2 to waive the balance fee of Rs.2,95,500/0 being demanded by them for correction of the subject of 57 students of 10th class of Government Secondary School (Boys) Mansa. Other prayers have also been made in the present petition.

2. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 and 2 has raised two preliminary objections. The first preliminary objection raised is that the letter dated 04.05.2023 (Annexure P-2) and letter dated 14.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) are not the subject matter of challenge in the present petition. The second preliminary objection is that the said letters have been addressed to the Principal, Government Secondary School (Boys), Mansa

and the recovery is to be effected from the school where the petitioners, work as teachers, and thus, they have no locus standi to file the present petition and in the present petition, the Principal has been arrayed as respondent no.3.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
