In compliance of the last order, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Traffic) SAS Nagar, Mohali is present in the Court.

The petitioner had filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to issue directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner unnecessarily by calling him to the office of respondents No.2 and 3. A further prayer was made to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to disclose about the contents of complaint filed by the respondent No.4 against him.

Learned State counsel submits that after holding the enquiry in the present case one FIR No.90 dated 30.11.2023 under Sections 420/406 of IPC, has been registered against the accused in the present case and the investigation shall be conducted by the police as per law.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, nothing

survives in the present petition and the petition is accordingly, disposed off.

Needless to say that, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedies, in accordance with law.
