This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for not obeying the directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 02.08.2023, 19.10.2023 and 30.10.2023 passed in COCP-2257-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has handed over compliance report by way of affidavit of Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh dated 30.11.2023 and affidavit of Gurpreet Singh Bhullar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Amritsar dated 29.11.2023. The same are taken on record.

As per the aforesaid affidavits, due action has been taken against the persons who were causing disturbance to the cable of the petitioner and 11 FIRs have already been registered by the State Police. Still further, it is mentioned in the said affidavits that they will take care that no undue disturbance is caused to the cable of the petitioner.

In response to the above, learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has instructions to not press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

The pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of as such.
