1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the Sub Depot Loharu has already been merged with the Bhiwani Depot by the Government vide letter dated 27.01.2023 and certain employees who were earlier posted in the Sub Depot Loharu have also been transferred to Bhiwani but the request of the petitioner for the same benefit is not being considered and the petitioner is being made to work at Sub Depot Loharu, which is arbitrary and illegal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 05.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned

Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 05.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a further period of four weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been treated as not pressed any further.
