1. This is a petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for grant of protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that FIR No. 101 dated 22.11.2019, under Sections 323, 354, 149, 506 and 451 IPC, was got registered at P.S. Begowal Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, (Annexure P-1) by the wife of the petitioner in the year 2019 which is still pending trial. In the meanwhile, the petitioner got recorded FIR No. 63 dated 19.10.2023, under Sections 304 and 34 IPC at Police Station Begowal, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala. He further contends that the petitioner and his family members are getting threats to their lives and liberty and has moved a representation dated 07.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Kapurthala), District Kapurthala, but no action has been taken on the said representation.

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 07.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) in an expeditious manner.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. AG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

6. After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 07.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.

7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.

8. Disposed of.
