1. The prayer of the petitioner in the present petition is that the contractual service which the husband of the petitioner had rendered with the department is to be taken into account as a qualifying service for determining the retirement benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been made by the petitioner in the representation dated 18.07.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-6, and the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, direction is given to the respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case the representation, Annexure P-6,

has been received in the office of the concerned authority and the same is still pending consideration, appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the passing of the order, the petitioner becomes entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to her within a further period of 4 weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
