1. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to the official respondents No. 2 and 3 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) expeditiously in accordance with the law.

2. It is, inter alia, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that aggrieved by the acts and conduct of respondent No. 4, the petitioner had been approaching the police for taking appropriate action. He has also moved a representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, but no action till date has been taken thereon.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if the directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) in an expeditious manner.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. AG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
