Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to consider and decide the representations dated 05.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) and dated 04.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner to respondents No.2 and 3 respectively within some stipulated period of time and further to rectify the revenue record in accordance with order of partition dated 30.06.2015 (Annexure P-2). Further prayer has been made to initiate departmental action against the erring revenue staff who have illegally transferred the property of the petitioner and his wife in the name of other persons in violation of the orders of the higher revenue authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed application dated 04.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) before respondent No.3-Director, Department of Revenue, Rehabilitation and Disaster management Punjab, Chandigarh but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondent

till date.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No.3-Director, Department of Revenue, Rehabilitation and Disaster management Punjab, Chandigarh is directed to decide the application dated 04.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within two months from today in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
