1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) by which, the claim of the petitioner for the grant of 2nd ACP and for stepping up of his pay equivalent to his junior, has been declined.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that impugned order dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) is totally cryptic and non-speaking and does not give any reason for declining the benefit as claimed by the petitioner in the present petition, hence the said order cannot sustain in the eyes of law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly submits that as no reason has been given for declining the benefit of 2nd ACP and step up of pay, the said order be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the authorities concerned to pass a fresh order and the fresh order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents that the impugned order has already been withdrawn, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
