Present writ petition was filed challenging the transfer order dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) pertaining to the petitioner.

While issuing notice of motion on 31.08.2018, the following order was passed:-

'Petitioner (Baljit Singh) is serving as 'Junior Engineer' in the Department of Cooperative Societies, Punjab, and has challenged his transfer from Sri Muktsar Sahib to Fazilka vide order dated 16.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) on the ground (i) that he is to retire on 31.05.2020, i.e., within two years; and (ii) he is a chronic heart patient, i.e., on sympathetic medical grounds.

It is urged that the petitioner is willing to give an undertaking that he will not seek any further extension, provided he is adjusted at near about of his previous place of posting.
