Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.1157 dated 22.10.2023 registered under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 188, 120-B of the IPC and Section 8(1) of the Haryana Public Examination (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 2021 registered at Police Station Sadar, Hisar.

CET Group-D examination of Haryana Government was being conducted at Om Sterling Global University Pharmacy Building, Hisar where petitioner had to appear as a candidate. Allegations are that in place of petitioner, some Sandeep was found to be appearing, by showing the fake ID Card of petitioner- Sachin.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was not found appearing in the examination; that petitioner is ready to join the investigation and he be granted necessary opportunity to join the same.

This Court finds no merit in the contention. Custodial interrogation of the petitioner may be required in order to know as to how the petitioner got prepared a fake Aadhar Card with photograph of Sandeep Kumar, on basis of which co-accused Sandeep was appearing at the place of petitioner.

This Court find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that in case petitioner applied for regular bail, the court concerned be directed not to be influenced by observation made in this order.

It is directed that if application for regular bail is moved, Court concerned will deal with the same in accordance with law.
