The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 11.12.2017(Annexure P-17) passed by respondent No.3 against the provisions of the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependent of deceased Government Employee Rules, 2006(Annexure P-13). The said rejection order is stated to be illegal and contrary on the ground that initially at the time of death of the husband of the petitioner Late Sh. Mahabir Singh, who was working as Assistant Lineman, the claim for compassionate employment was declined.

The instant petition was dismissed in default vide order dated 25.07.2019 and thereafter restored vide order dated 30.08.2019. Subsequent to order of restoration dated 30.08.2019, an application dated 25.09.2019 has been made by the petitioner that she will be satisfied, if according to the Rules of the
