The present petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularise the services of the petitioner from the date, juniors to petitioner have been regularised, alongwith all consequential benefits and arrears.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents-Department. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 11.05.2022, Annexure P-6, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sanjeev Kaushik, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the pending legal notice shall be decided by respondent no.2 expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-Director General School Education, Panchkula, Haryana, to consider and decide the pending legal notice, dated 11.05.2022, Annexure P-6, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from receiving a certified copy of this order.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹ 25,000 to the petitioner.
