The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, praying for issuance of directions to the respondent for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 07.03.2022, passed by this Court in CWP 1986-2022.

Counsel for the respondent submits that since the respondent has considered the claim of the petitioner and, in fact, the same has been acceded to, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he would be at liberty to raise his grievance in an appropriate proceeding before the appropriate Court, in accordance with law.
